

LIVINGSTON PIECEMAKERS QUILT GUILD

BLOCK OF THE MONTH SEPTEMBER, 2011

FRIENDSHIP STAR – 12"

Supply list:

Color one – one 4-1/2" square and one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" rectangle

Color two – white muslin from Jean's Corner.

four 4-1/2" squares and one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" rectangle

Place the two rectangles, right sides together, lightest fabric on top. Lightly draw a line 4-7/8" from the short side, dividing the piece in half. Then draw two diagonal lines through the center of the two squares. Sew 1/4" away from the diagonal lines on each square.

Cut the rectangles apart on the drawn lines, creating four half-square triangle components. Press seams to the darker fabric. The finished unit should measure 4-1/2".

Piece two of the half-square triangle components with the 4-1/2" color one fabric square to create the center row.

Press the seams toward the center square.

Create the upper and lower block rows by piecing together one of the half-square triangle blocks with two 4-1/2" white blocks.

Press the seams out toward the white blocks,

Piece the three block rows together to create the finished block. Press the seams toward the outside edge of the block. The finished block should measure 12-1/2".
