IRISH CROSSROADS – 12"

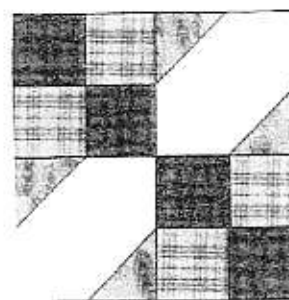
Supply list:

Color 3 Natural muslin from Jean's Corner.

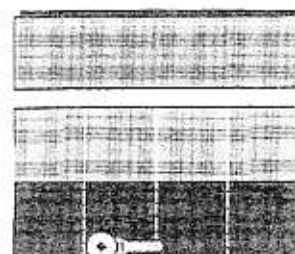
1 6 1/2" by 13" strip

Colors 1, 2 & 4 – your choice

1 3 1/2" by 14" strip from each color



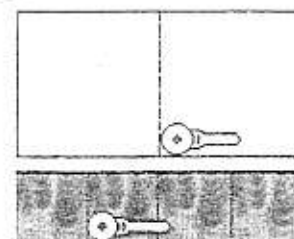
Stack colors 1 & 2 strips, right sides together. Sew along one long edge, using a scant 1/4" seam. Press seam toward darker fabric. Mark and cut this 2 color rectangle, into 4 3 1/2" by 6 1/2" rectangles.



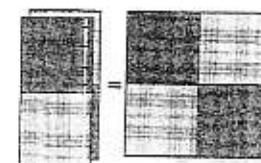
Mark and cut color 3 (natural muslin) into 2 6 1/2" squares.

Mark and cut color 4 into 4 3 1/2" squares.

Mark a diagonal line on the back of a color 4 square. Align one with the upper left corner of a color 3 square – right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Cut away the excess fabric. Press the seam toward the darker fabric. Do the same with another color 4 on the opposite side of the color 3 square. Make 2 of these.



Sew together 2 colors 1 & 2 combinations, using a scant 1/4". Make 2 of these.



Place a four square unit with a "road" unit to make row one and again to make row two. Sew the two rows together.
