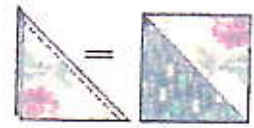
BLOCK OF THE MONTH MAY, 2011

DEPRESSION BLOCK – 12"

Supply list:

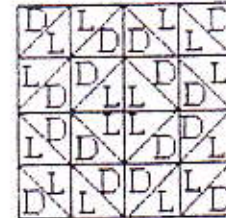
16 4-inch dark blocks (any scraps)

16 4-inch blocks natural muslin from Jean's Corner.



Cut the 16 light blocks and the 16 dark scrap blocks each in half on the diagonal. Sew a light half square triangle to a half square triangle of a dark. Press seams to the darker material and trim the block to measure 3 1/2 inches.

Lay out the squares with the dark (D) and the light (L) arranged as shown at right.



Piece the block by sewing four horizontal rows. Join the rows and it's done.

This block pattern is from the 1930's and is reminiscent of the times. Let's be frugal about this and not waste scraps
